Project Summary:

This project aims to reach out to different stakeholders on Peng Chau and establishes a cross-sectoral collaboration platform, “Peng Chau Caring Alliance”, to jointly take care of the frail and needy elderly on the island. Moreover, the project plans to motivate the elderly and women on the island to set up the “Peng Chau Happy Volunteer Group” to provide different types of support services to the elderly in need in the community, promote the caring culture on Peng Chau and let the elderly enjoy their old age there.

Programmes include:

- 1) “Peng Chau Caring Alliance”: to mobilise Peng Chau and external stakeholders including community organisations, social welfare organisations, district council members’ offices, health care organisations, business and social enterprises, etc., to establish a cross-sectoral collaboration platform for jointly organising regular activities caring for the elderly on Peng Chau and consolidating the community support network. The Alliance will also organise the “Peng Chau Cares Alliance Social Capital Promotion Day” to introduce the concept of social

capital to residents and stakeholders in the community and share with them the achievements of building social capital.

- 2) “Peng Chau Happy Volunteer Group”: to recruit elders and women from the community to provide them with the knowledge about volunteer services and skills training with a view to transforming them into volunteers. In addition, it provides different support services for the community including “Dancing Peng Chau”, “Happy Ageing Shop”, “Elderly Playmate”, “Historic Sites and Scenic Tours on Peng Chau” and “Dementia Ambassador Service”.
