

"Auntie Angel" Companion Project for New Born Babies and Families (0016-20)

Project Summary

“Auntie Angel” Companion Project for New Born Babies and Families is a project to consolidate cross-sector collaboration for providing mutual help and support to new parents in Tsuen Wan, Kwai Tsing and Sham Shui Po, especially those from low-income and new arrival families who have weak social networks and problem-solving abilities. This project would employ three strategies for building social capital, including knowledge transfer, snow ball effect and cross-sector collaboration. The mutual help networks of new parents can be formulated through the collaboration with different stakeholders in the community such as women with child care experiences, nursing professional, teachers and students of university, new parents who have participated in the project and other community organisations. Parents participating in the project will be empowered and transformed to assist other parents in need, generating a snow-balling effect.
