

“Withdrawn Youth Support Network Enhancement Project” - Hong Kong Christian Service

Project Summary

“Withdrawn Youth Support Network Enhancement Project” is a continuation of the “Withdrawn Youth Support Network Project” (WYSNP). This new Project serves two major types of youths: those young people who have successfully broken through social withdrawal status and those young people who are still hiding themselves at home. “Building social network” is the key strategy of this new Project. We will further consolidate different types of social resources and support through establishing network with business partners, and extend our networks to schools and related organizations in the community. Ultimately, we will line up enterprises and different groups of volunteers to support those socially withdrawn youth and those “rehabilitated” youth to re-build social capital and actualize the belief that “everyone is born with talent”.
